Don't Toss Everything Out

Romans 4:19-25

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There is one thing we need keep for sure, and that is **faith**.

Jesus answered “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” (John 14:6)

How can we walk in faith? Look at the example of Abraham.

Romans 4:19-25

19 Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead—since he was about a hundred years old—and that Sarah’s womb was also dead. 20 Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God, 21 being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised. 22 This is why “it was credited to him as righteousness.” 23 The words “it was credited to him” were written not for him alone, 24 but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead. 25 He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

1. He didn't weaken in faith (Romans 4:19).
2. He didn't waver in faith (Romans 4:20).
3. He was strengthened in faith (Romans 4:20).
4. Believe fully that God has the power to do what he has promised. (Romans 4:21)
5. This faith is also for all of us. (Romans 4:24)

God credits not only Abraham but all of us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead.

You can be like Abram and be a blessing to the nations. God is the one who equips us with everything we need to do what God has called us to do. ---Amen
