## Don't Toss Everything Out

Romans 4:19-25 Loyd Flaherty

There is one thing we need keep for sure, and that is **faith**.

Jesus answered "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

**How can we walk in faith?** Look at the example of Abraham.

## Romans 4:19-25

19 <u>Without weakening</u> in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead—since he was about a hundred years old—and that Sarah's womb was also dead. 20 Yet he <u>did not waver</u> through unbelief regarding the <u>promise of God</u>, but was <u>strengthened</u> in his faith and gave glory to God, 21 being <u>fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised</u>. 22 This is why "it was credited to him as <u>righteousness</u>." 23 The words "it was credited to him" were written not for him alone, 24 <u>but also for us</u>, to whom God will credit righteousness—<u>for us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead</u>. 25 He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

- 1. He didn't weaken in faith (Romans 4:19).
- 2. He didn't waver in faith (Romans 4:20).
- 3. He was strengthened in faith (Romans 4:20).
- 4. Believe fully that God has the power to do what he has promised. (Romans 4:21)
- 5. This faith is also for all of us. (Romans 4:24)

God credits not only Abraham but all of us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead.

You can be like Abram and be a blessing to the nations. God is the one who equips us with everything we need to do what God has called us to do. --- Amen
