Psalm 100

Psalm 100 “Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. 2 Worship (serve) the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. 3 Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. 4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. 5 For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Making a joyful song

This joyful song is never to be aimless; it is directed to the Lord.

2. SERVE THE LORD

Psalm 100:2 Worship/Serve with gladness, serving/worshiping as one who is loved, not serving to be loved.

3. COME INTO HIS PRESENCE WITH SINGING

We sing praise about who and what we love.
