1. Walk by Faith Not by Sight

We want to be “In the know” and to have clarity—to see what’s up ahead. Walking in faith isn’t walking in clarity. Walking in faith is trusting and following.

2 Corinthians 5:7 “For we live by faith, not by sight.”

2. Don't Take a Suitcase Full

Jesus told his disciples to go but don't take extra provisions.

Matthew 10:9-10 “Do not get any gold or silver or copper to take with you in your belts— 10 no bag for the journey or extra shirt or sandals or a staff, for the worker is worth his keep.”

3. Where do we place our trust?

Jesus says **Matthew 24:35** “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.”

We want to have a detailed map but the Bible tells us to walk in the Spirit. We ask for wisdom for our future but Jesus says, “Follow me.” We want all the answers but the Lord tells us to trust Him.

Psalm 62:8 “Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge.”
