Why Trust?

Proverbs 3:5-6

1. Relying on God's Wisdom

Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

This verse in Proverbs teaches us to trust in God and to rely on His wisdom, rather than our own understanding. There is a limit to our own understanding. We miss out on God's wisdom if we don't trust Him.

Relying on God's wisdom is putting our trust in God.

2. Peace in God's Presence

Psalms 46:10 "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

When we trust in God in all circumstances we have peace in His presence.

3. Hope and Encouragement

Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

This verse reminds us that God is with us and that He will help us through any challenges we may face.

Application:

This year we could experience some difficulties as well as new wonderful opportunities. Either way, let's put our faith in God and trust in Him.
