1. A Community of Worship

“Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord”

Psalm 95 1-7

1 Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.

2 Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song. 3 For the Lord is the great God, the great King above all gods.

4 In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. 5 The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land. 6 Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker; 7 for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.

Reading Psalm 95 reminds us to focus on God's greatness rather than our daily worries. When we come together to worship, it uplifts all of us, reminding us of God's might and strength.

2. Outreach and Service

It is clear that Jesus taught his disciples to go, and make disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 28:19-20 *Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”*
