## I Am the Vine

John 15:1-17 James Brown

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit." John 15:5

#### 1. Commands for our good

John 15:10 "If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love."

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Because God loves us and wants what's best for us, He gives us His commands in the Bible so that we can lead the most fruitful life possible.

## 2. Pruning for fruitfulness
