I Believe, Help My Unbelief!

Mark 9:24 James Brown

1. Looking at evidence

Mark 9:24. Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!"

Nobody has perfect faith. God works to strengthen and mature our faith after we choose to follow Jesus. He can use evidence or miracles to do that. God's goodness towards us doesn't depend on our level of faith in Him.

2. Accepting by faith

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

3. Assurance of salvation
