## **Keep Going with Jesus**

Acts 14 Loyd Flaherty

Even when life gets difficult or confusing, keep going with Jesus.

- 1. When People Oppose You Keep Going Acts 14:1–7 (In Iconium)
  - Even when people opposed Paul and Barnabas, they could keep going because they were powered by the Lord's grace enabling them to preform signs and wonders.
  - Even when others push back. Don't give up. Keep going with Jesus.
- 2. When People Praise You Point to Jesus Acts 14:8–20 (In Lystra)
  - Sometimes people will admire you, but remember where your strength comes from. It's easy to think, "I did that." But Paul says, "We didn't do this. God did."
- 3. When Life is Hard Keep Trusting
  Acts 14:21–28 (Return to Antioch and Report)
  - Paul and Barnabas reported all that God had done.
  - Life isn't easy. You may be tired, stressed, sick, or just discouraged. But that doesn't mean God isn't with you. They tell the people "We must go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God."
  - Jesus is with you in every hardship. He is using your story to to help encourage others.

## **Conclusion: Keep Going with Jesus**

No matter what you're facing—opposition, success, or suffering—don't stop. Jesus is not finished. He's working through your life to bring hope, healing, and faith to you and others around you.

## Are you trusting Jesus with your heart and future?
