## **Being Used by God**

Exodus 3:11-12 James Brown

#### 1. I will be with you

Exodus 3:11-12 But Moses said to God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" And God said, "I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain."

It can be easy to feel like we are not suitable or not qualified to be used by God. But the work of God's Kingdom doesn't depend on us. It depends only on God who is at work through us and who promises to be with us.

#### 2. Making disciples

Matthew 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

We are all called to share the love of Jesus with the people around us. God has prepared good works for each one of us from before we were even born. Only you can fulfil the good works which God has prepared in advance for you.

### 3. Staying humble

2 Corinthians 4:6-7 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ. But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

We glorify God in our weaknesses. The only person God can't use is a prideful person. If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all. True humility means thinking of God and other people before yourself.
