Living Water

Psalm 42:1, John 4:14 and John 4:28-30 Loyd Flaherty

1. We All Get Thirsty

Just like our bodies need water, our hearts and souls need God. We often feel tired, empty, lonely, or restless — this is spiritual thirst.

Psalm 42:1 "As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God.

2. Jesus Offers Living Water

John 4:14 "Whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst."

Jesus meets a woman who was **spiritually thirsty**—but she didn't even know that she was. The water that Jesus gives satisfies deep inside and lasts forever.

3. Drink Deeply and Share It

"Drink deeply" means to fully receive and continually be refreshed from Jesus. Jesus doesn't just want to give you a sip of encouragement now and then —He wants to fill you fully and refresh you daily.

John 4:28-30

"28 Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, 29 "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?" 30 They came out of the town and made their way toward him."

When Jesus fills us, we overflow — we want to share with others."

Conclusion:

Jesus doesn't just give us water — He is the water. Wherever you are — dry, tired, or full of questions — come to Jesus and drink living water.
