Encourage and Build Up One Another

Hebrews 10:24–25

Encouraging and building up is more than holding back hurtful words — it's actively helping each other grow.

Hebrews 10:24–25 “And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

1. Stir One Another Toward Growth

Encouragement isn't random—it takes thought and intention (“let us consider”).

2. Encourage One Another All the More

Hebrews 10:25b “...but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

As the world gets darker, the church's words should get brighter.

3. Speaking Life into Each Other

1 Thessalonians 5:11 “Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.”

Our words can either tear down or build up — God calls us to speak life.

Conclusion:

- Actively help each other grow.
- Replace criticism with blessing in order to speak life and build each other up.
