## A Life Under Construction

2 Peter 3:18

When Antoni Gaudí began designing the great Sagrada Família cathedral in Barcelona, he knew he would never see it finished. That unfinished cathedral is a reminder that our lives, too, are still under construction. We are not finished yet—we are meant to keep growing, day by day, until the day we see Jesus face to face.

### 1. Growing Until We See Him Face to Face

**1 Corinthians 13:12** “Now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face.”

Until that day, we are still growing, being shaped by His love and grace.

### 2. Unfinished and Still Growing

We are meant to keep growing all our lives.

Growth means a deeper relationship with Jesus, not just more information about Him.

### 3. Every Aspect Points to God's Glory
