1 Corinthians 13:13

1 Corinthians 13:13 “And now these three remain: **faith**, hope, and love. But the greatest of these is love.”

Paul writes in this letter to the Corinthians that many spiritual gifts are temporary, but faith, hope, and love will last forever.

1. Faith Starts with Trust
