When God Says "Look Up"

Genesis 15:5-6 Loyd Flaherty

Genesis 15:5-6

He took him outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars—if indeed you can count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be." 6 Abram believed the Lord, and he credited it to him as righteousness.

1. Faith Begins When We Trust God's Promise

Genesis 15:6 " Abram believed the LORD, and He counted it to him as righteousness."

- Righteousness is a relationship word.
- Being righteous means we are now in right standing with God.

2. Faith Receives What Only God Can Do

- We don't earn righteousness, we receive it.
- Abram didn't "work for" God's promise. He simply believed it.

Ephesians 2:8 "By grace you have been saved through faith — and not of yourselves, it is the gift of God — "

• Faith is not payment. Faith is receiving God's gift.

3. Faith Produces a New Way of Living

Abram's faith changed how he lived: He followed God, waited on God, and obeyed God.

Romans 1:17

Just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

• Faith makes us righteous, and righteousness shapes our lives.

Summary

Believe God's Promise — Faith believes God's word.

Receive God's Gift — Faith receives righteousness through Jesus.

Live God's Way — Faith changes the way we live.
