Hebrews 11:24-27

1. Not seeking this world's honor

Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter.

God can use anyone who through faith chooses to walk with Him. That means openly identifying yourself with Jesus. We may lose the honour of this world, but we gain the honour of God. Focusing on that gives us the strength we need to persevere.

2. Becoming one with God's family

Hebrews 11:25 He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin.

3. Having Godly values
