## Wonderful Creator

Psalm 19:1-2

### 1. God created this world

*Psalm 19:1-2 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge.*

When we look at nature we don't just think, 'what a wonderful world.' We think, 'what a wonderful God!' All of nature displays His glory. When we look at nature it is much easier to accept the existence of a creator God than it is to try and deny it.

### 2. Creation reveals the creator

*Job 12:7-10 Ask the animals, and they will teach you, or the birds in the sky, and they will tell you; or speak to the earth, and it will teach you, or let the fish in the sea inform you. Which of all these does not know that the hand of the LORD has done this? In his hand is the life of every creature and the breath of all mankind.*

Creation is God's work of art. Art reveals the heart of the artist. God didn't just create the world and then abandon it. He is intimately involved in every aspect of His creation. He knows everything about us. And He loves us completely.

### 3. Our response

*Romans 8:19, 21 Creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed... that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom of the glory of God.*

The greatest work of God in all creation was to come to this earth in the form of a man. Nature as we know it is far from perfect. But God is preparing a perfect world for anyone who chooses to follow Jesus.
