1 Peter 2:5 “you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.”

We are people God is building together.

1. We Belong to Jesus

When we put our faith in Jesus, we become part of His Church. The word **“living stones”** is important. We are not dead pieces of a building. We have new life because of Jesus.

You are not just someone who goes to church. You are part of the Church.

2. We Belong Together

One stone doesn't make a house.

Peter says we are **“Being built into a spiritual house”** God isn't finished.

3. We Live for God
